AndroScience Corporation's abstract entitled "**Androgen Receptor Degradation (ARD) Enhancer: A Potential Application for Topical Treatment of Acne Vulgaris**" has been accepted for presentation (selected for Poster Exhibit and Poster Discussion Sessions) at the 64th Annual Meeting of the American Academy of Dermatology to be held on March 3 - 7, 2006 in San Francisco.

The ARD Enhancers are a group of small molecules discovered by AndroScience, that express activity in regulating androgen-induced activities in various animal models. Using ARD-Enhancers as topical drugs to treat acne represents a potential breakthrough in the treatment of acne vulgaris, and will be the first of its kind as a topical drug that targets on the cause rather than the symptoms of the disease.
